



2009 NWIBL ADULT WOOD BAT SUMMER LEAGUE TEAM CONTRACT

1. 2009 NWIBL Adult Wood Bat Summer League play will consist of each team playing 20 league games and Double elimination league championship tournament. Team fee includes two umpires per game, 5 dozen game baseballs, field use fees; general field liability insurance, advertising and administrative expenses. Team uniform and equipment expense are not included in the team fee. Teams are responsible for the team wearing matching team uniforms. Teams will be provided combination for locks to open, and close the stadiums. NWIBL will provide a scoreboard operator and announcer only for league tournament games played at Sckavone Field and Walker Stadium. If teams wish to have a person of age 15 or older to operate this they may do so during summer season.
2. League play will begin May 16 and conclude August 15. There will be no league games May 23, 24 & 25 (Memorial Day Weekend) or July 3,4 & 5 (4th of July Weekend). All teams will then advance to the League Championship Double elimination Tournaments, scheduled for August 6 thru 15
3. Team registration and payment deadline May 1, 2009. (April 15: Team deposit of \$1,500 due (Non-Refundable)) May 1 2009: Remaining team balances of \$2,250 due (Non-Refundable) with min. 8 teams and \$2675 if 6 teams; 8 or more teams player fee is \$250 team fee is \$3,750; 6 teams player fee is \$275 (team fee \$4,125) *\$250 late fee will be assessed to team fees if either deposit of \$1,500 or final team payment is late. *May 1: Last date to register team for 2009 NWIBL Adult Wood Bat Summer League Non-Refundable
4. NWIBL will release a complete season schedule by May 2, 2009. To teams that have paid. NWIBL will re-schedule all rained out games and as needed the re-assigning of games under forfeit rule.
5. Teams forfeiting NWIBL Adult Wood Bat Summer League or League Tournament games BECAUSE OF FIELDING LESS THAN 8 PLAYERS will be assessed the forfeit loss and will also have that one game taken away from their schedule. Teams forfeiting a game(s) after July 1 will pay \$50 per forfeit to regain their league tournament eligibility. The \$50 will go to league entertainment events. (If \$50 fees are not paid then that team will not be allowed to continue to play and will be assed a \$50 fee for each game not played.
6. Teams are responsible for submitting their complete team roster to NWIBL, 15 player minimum and 20 player maximum, due at registration and official League Tournament roster due June 30, 2009. Each manager must submit two pieces of completed and signed paperwork for each player, 1) Player contract and 2) Player code of conduct. NWIBL must have proper paperwork on file for each player to be eligible. If NWIBL doesn't have completed and signed paperwork on file the player is not eligible. If a team uses a in eligible player at any time that game will be forfeited and fined of \$250 will be collected before that team is allowed to play. Use the FREE AGENT POOL TO GET ELIGIBLE PLAYES. If a second infraction occurs then there will be a 3 game forfeit penalty. If this were to occur again then League Managers will determine the punishment.
7. Ineligible player participation in a NWIBL Adult Wood Bat Summer League or League Tournament game will be cause for forfeiture of game(s) participated in. Teams forfeiting games are subject to the NWIBL forfeiture rule stated in item #5 AND 6 listed above.
8. Teams failing to submit their official tournament roster by June 30, 2009 will not be eligible for league tournament play. Players added to rosters after June 30 are eligible for league play but not post season play unless the player is added due to a injury. (Players replaced will be ineligible for Tournament play)
9. Exact team line-up cards fur every game. To accurately monitor player eligibility it is important that each team submit a proper line-up card prior to each game. All team rosters will be posted to NWIBL.org Web Site
